

# Behaviour Management

## Rationale

The Board affirms the belief that students learn best in a positive environment that is free from fear and disruption so that all students may reach their learning potential.

The behaviour management system and procedures in the school then seeks to build a climate of purposeful order and students will be brought to account for behaviour which breaches school rules, standards of accepted behaviour, disrupts their own, or the learning of others or for unsafe, intimidating and threatening behaviour.

## Guidelines

1. To ensure all students and their families are provided with clear statements of school expectations in the Parents' Handbook and Student Diary and other communications as necessary for student behaviour.
2. To use the Behaviour Management Back-up System and Procedures as developed by the Principal and staff.
3. To ensure that the Staff Manual has an outline of behaviour management and guidance systems.
4. Any intervention made under this policy does not preclude referral to an appropriate outside agency (eg Police, CYFS) or the matter being dealt with under other policies the school has in place.
