

Greymouth High School Refunds and Cancellations for International Students

This Policy is based on Section 48 (7) of the Education Amendment Act: No 4, 1991.

1. If notice of cancellation is received in writing two weeks before the start of the course, full tuition fees will be refunded less any agency fee already paid and an administration fee of \$250.00.
2. If a home stay has been arranged, a Placement Fee of \$250.00 will be deducted.
3. If a student wishes to cancel study after the course has started this must be done within the first two weeks of the course. Costs will be deducted according to the length of study already undertaken.
4. Full fees will not normally be refunded after the second week of study. (Full refunds after the second week will be made only on compassionate grounds at the discretion of Greymouth High School.
5. No refunds of tuition fees will be made to students who are asked to leave Greymouth High School as a result of breaking the school rules or New Zealand law. A refund of unused Home stay fees will be paid less a two weeks fee.

Fees Protection

Greymouth High School Board of Trustees guarantees a refund of unspent fees to International Students in the unlikely event of the school not being able to deliver its normal programme.
