

# Grown-ups read this...

- Make sure that children know the safest route to the bus stop. Better still, drop them off so they don't have to cross the road.
- Park your car out of the way of the bus or other children. Tell children the importance of waiting quietly and not playing games that could have them running onto the road.
- If you are picking children up from the bus stop, wait on the same side of the road as the bus stops. Don't call out for children to come to you from across the road. Have an alternative plan in case you are running late.
- Make sure that children are as visible as possible, by wearing bright and/or light-coloured clothing, or by using reflective strips or tape.
- Discuss and practise the points in this pamphlet with your children regularly.
