Students will have an **individual learning plan** to complement their time with you.

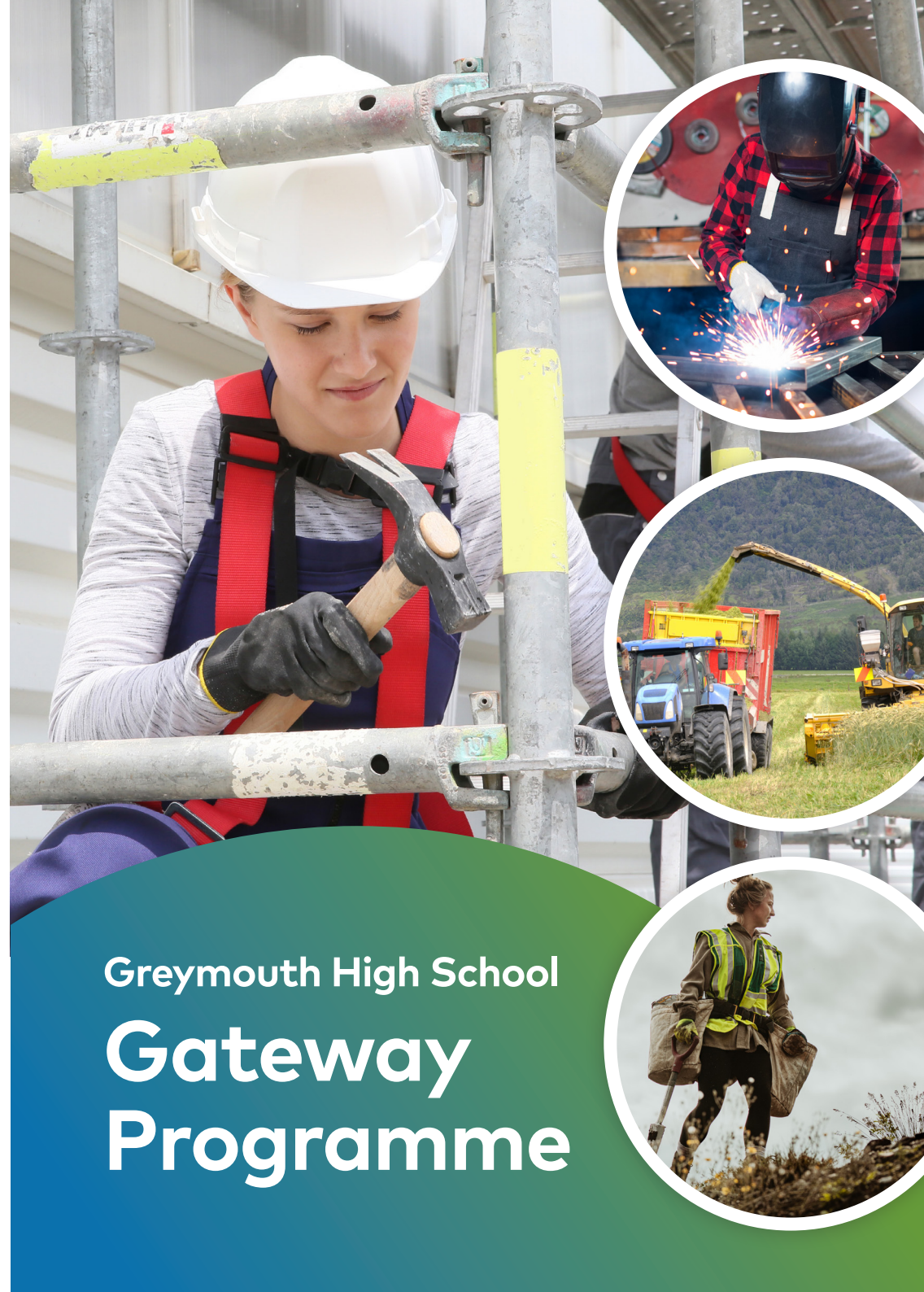

Gateway Programme

Greymouth High School wants to help shape the future of the West Coast's employment.

The Gateway Programme provides 'structured workplace learning' which allows students to gain new skills and knowledge in a workplace, while studying industry-related credits towards NCEA qualifications.

How it works



Students will get a minimum of **10 placement days** with an employer to go hand in hand with studying industry related credits.



An **individual learning plan** is created with students to ensure they are fully supported in achieving their studies.



The Gateway Programme is **fully funded** by the Tertiary Education Commission and all work placement equipment and clothing is provided.
